

# Impact Of the Michigan Pilot Project

A partnership between the Michigan Council of Developmental Disabilities and Elevatus Training.

## YEAR 1: 2018

11 self-advocates with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) and professionals were trained as sexuality educator teaching teams.

### People Impacted:

- 208 Family Members
- 253 Transition Staff
- 130 Agencies
- 476 People with I/DD

## YEAR 2: 2019

15 additional self-advocates and professional sexuality educator teaching teams were trained—26 teams total.

### People Impacted:

- +20 (228) Family Members
- +32 (285) Transition Staff
- +26 (156) Agencies
- +166 (642) People with I/DD

## YEAR 3: 2020

### Trained Sexuality Educators:

- 81 People with I/DD
- 185 Professionals and Parents

### People Impacted:

- +77 (305) Family Members
- +643 (928) Transition Staff
- +2,037 (2,193) Agencies
- +1372 (2,014) People with I/DD

Since this project's first three-year pilot phase, many additional people have benefited.

### 15 train-the-trainers were trained to continue the project.

On-going training opportunities are offered for skill enhancement and team networking.
